## RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING ZONING PETITION S86-45

WHEREAS, the Board of County Canmissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Elorida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

whereas, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. S86-45 was presented to the Board of County Canmissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on November 18, 1986 and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Caxmissioners made the following findings of fact:

NOW, THEREFORE, LE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA that: Petition No. S86-45 (regarding Zoning Petition No. 77-153, Resolution No. R-77-1249) the petition of the Board of County Commissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, to revoke the Special Exception for a Commercial New and Used Auto Sale, Rental and Repair Facility and Lot on the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, less the West 53 feet for road right-of-way, in Section 12, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, located on the east side of Military Trail, approximately 0.4 of a mile north of Forest Hill boulevard was withdrawn, without prejudice.
