## RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION NO. 80-66(C) F'ET I TION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 16.3 and Chapter-125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 80-66(C) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Author-i ty, at its public hearing conducted on July 24, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to the criteria set forth in the Zoning Code of Palm Beach County, Florida, Sections 102, 200.2 (Special Exception) 402.2A, 402.9, 500.12 and 610 has; considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. Al though this proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Flan and local land development regulations, the previous approval is also consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive. Plan and local land development regulations, including Sect ion 402.9 of the Zoning Code and the conditions of the previous approval have been satisfied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. 80-66 (C), the petition of THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, by CAROL ROBERTS, CHAIR, to REVOKE A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR A CHILD DAY CARE CENTER, F'HEVIOUSLY APPROVED UNDER ZONING PETITION NO. 80-66 (E) ON OCTOBER 3, 1984 (R-85-464, ADDPTED MARCH 19, 1985) on the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, LESS, however, the North 495.0 feet and the East 157.83 feet thereof, as measures at right angles to the boundary lines of the said Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 and LESS the Right-of-Way for Coconut Road and Mil i tary Trai 1 (SR 809).
