

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 1715

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 AMENDING SHEET NO. 26 OF THE PALM BEACH COUNTY
5 OFFICIAL ZONING MAP BY DELETING ZONING
6 DESIGNATIONS FOR CERTAIN PROPERTIES ON
7 INDIANTOWN ROAD BETWEEN I-95AND CENTER STREET;
8 PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT;
9 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR
10 INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWSAND ORDINANCES OF
11 PALM BEACH COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **WHEREAS**, on August 31, 1989, the Palm Beach County Board of County
14 Commissioners adopted the 1989 Comprehensive Plan by Ordinance No. 89-17; and

15 **WHEREAS**, on March 30, 1995, the Palm Beach County Board of County
16 Commissioners entered into a Joint Agreement for Planning and Administration of Land
17 Development Regulations in the Jupiter Road Overlay (IOZ) Zoning District with the Town of
18 Jupiter by Resolution No. 95-424D; and

19 **WHEREAS**, on December 6, 1995, the Palm Beach County Board of County
20 Commissioners amended the Comprehensive Plan by deleting future land use designations
21 designation for certain properties along Indiantown Road between I-95 and Center Street by
22 Ordinance No. 95-57; and

23 **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to delete the Palm Beach County zoning designations for
24 certain properties along Indiantown Road between I-95 and Center Street to implement the
25 Comprehensive Plan and Joint Agreement for Planning and Administration with the Town of
26 Jupiter.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY**
28 **COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

29 **Part I. Amendment to the Palm Beach County Official Zonina Map**

30 The following amendment to the Palm Beach County Official Zoning Map is hereby
31 adopted:

- 32 A. Sheet No. 26 is hereby amended to delete Palm Beach County zoning
33 designations on certain properties in unincorporated Palm Beach County
34 fronting on Indiantown Road east of I-95 and west of Center Street, as shown

1 in Exhibit 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2 **Part II. Repeal of Laws in Conflict**

3 All local laws and ordinances applying to the unincorporated area of Palm Beach
4 County in conflict with any provision of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of
5 such conflict.

6 **Part III. Severability**

7 If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is for any
8 reason held by the Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not
9 affect the remainder of this resolution.

10 **Part IV. Inclusion in the Code of Laws and Resolutions**

11 The provisions of this resolution shall become and be made a part of the code of laws
12 and resolutions of Palm Beach County, Florida. The sections of this resolution may be
13 renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "resolution " may be changed to
14 "section," "article," or any other appropriate word.

15 **Part V. Effective Date**

16 The effective date of this resolution shall be immediately upon adoption of a ordinance
17 by the Town of Jupiter establishing zoning designations for the subject properties.

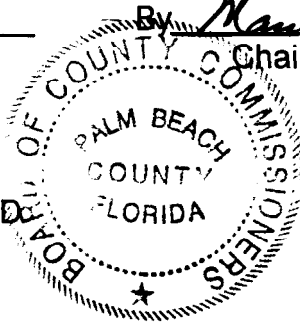


EXHIBIT 1
