

RESOLUTION NO. R-94-942

RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTION R-91-1721  
ADMINISTRATIVE ABANDONMENT ZONING PETITION 78-287(G)  
PETITION OF COREPOINT CORP.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Petition 78-287(G) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing conducted on September 4, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-91-1721 approving this petition was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on November 26, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director has determined that the request to administratively abandon the development order, as provided for in Article 5 (Development Review Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (Ordinance 92-20, as amended), meets the requirements contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director has administratively abandoned the development order, as provided for in Article 5 (Development Review Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code (Ordinance 92-20, as amended); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director presented the abandonment of the development order to the Board of County Commissioners for ratification on July 28, 1994; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 5.3.D.9 (Action by Board of County Commissioners) of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Resolution R-91-1721 approving Zoning Petition 78-287(G), the petition of Corepoint Corp. for a special exception to amend the master plan to add two access points to the PUD is hereby revoked.

Commissioner Roberts moved for the approval of the Resolution.

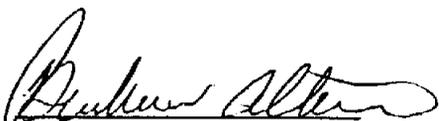
The motion was seconded by Commissioner Aaronson and, upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
