RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTION R-1762 AFFIRMING THE ADMINISTRATIVE ABANDONMENT OF ZONING PETITION 79-260

Doyal, Agent, for a Special Exception to allow a concrete mixing and product manufacturing facility is beachy revoked. facility is hereby revoked.
