

ZONING RESOLUTION #3-C-64

MODIFYING THE REGULATIONS  
TO ALLOW TWO WAY RADIO TOWERS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS

ADOPTED MAY 7, 1964

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 7th day of May, A. D. 1964, that the following modification is hereby adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution #3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959:

Add the following after Section 4-B-13:

14. Two way radio towers not exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above the ground, provided such towers are located in such a manner that they would not fall on power lines or adjacent property.

Delete Section 4-C-2 as written and substitute the following:

2. Public utility structures and buildings such as sewage disposal plants and electric substations.

Add the following after Section 4-C-17:

18. Commercial radio and television transmitter stations and towers.
19. Two way radio towers exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above the ground, or so located that they would fall on power lines or adjacent property.

Delete Section 4-E as written and substitute the following:

E. Building Height Regulations

No building or structure shall exceed thirty five (35) feet in height except that structures incidental to an agricultural enterprise such as silos, granaries, elevators, windmills, storage warehouses, mills, barns and two way radio towers may exceed the above limits subject to the provisions of Section 14-10.

Add the following after Section 9-B-9:

10. Two way radio towers not exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above the ground provided such towers are located in such a manner that they would not fall on power lines or adjacent property.

Add the following after Section 9-C-2:

3. Two way radio towers exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above the ground or so located that they would fall on power lines or adjacent property.

Add the following after Section 10-C-2:

3. Two way radio towers exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above the ground, or so located that they would fall on power lines or adjacent property.

Add the following after Section 11-1-B-2(e):

- (f) Two way radio towers exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above the ground or so located that they would fall on power lines or adjacent property.
