I am writing to express my interest in the position of County Administrator for Palm Beach County. With over two decades of global executive leadership experience—including significant public sector roles at Dallas/Fort Worth (DFW) International Airport and the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA)—I offer a unique blend of strategic vision, operational excellence, and cross-functional leadership. My career reflects a proven ability to lead complex, matrixed organizations through crisis, growth, transformation, and innovation—skills essential to stewarding a County as dynamic and diverse as Palm Beach.

I have successfully led through some of the most challenging moments in public service, including a **mass casualty event with 15 lives lost**, a **cybersecurity attack** that disrupted light rail operations across San Jose for nearly a month, and the organizational pressures of **COVID-19**. At the same time, I've also been at the helm of transformational growth initiatives, such as overseeing awards and procurements for the **\$12 Billion Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) Phase II Extension to San Jose**.

At **Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority**, I played a key leadership role in managing procurement and contracting strategies for one of Northern California's largest transit systems. I successfully balanced the needs of capital infrastructure expansion with day-to-day operations (Light Rail, Congestion Management, Highway Construction and Toll Road System Management)—advancing multimillion-dollar public projects that enhanced regional mobility and fueled economic development. My ability to collaborate with elected boards, department heads, and community stakeholders was central to advancing **multi-billion-dollar initiatives** across the County.

Prior to that, at **DFW International Airport**, the world's second-largest airport by land area and third busiest by passenger traffic, I served in a senior leadership role directing enterprise-wide procurement and contract management operations for both airside and landside functions. I implemented strategic sourcing models, streamlined vendor engagement, and drove measurable cost savings while enhancing compliance and transparency. My contributions supported the airport's mission of delivering world-class service while meeting rigorous public accountability standards. Notably, in **October 2001**, I drafted a comprehensive **Contingency Plan in the post-**

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**9/11 environment** to support the successful sale of **\$3 Billion in bonds**, which was critical to completing the DFW's Capital Development Program.

These public sector experiences—complemented by leadership roles in global private firms with responsibilities spanning 26 countries—have shaped my leadership style, which is rooted in **transparency, accountability, and collaboration**. I have led teams of over 100 professionals across various disciplines and geographies, managed complex budgets totaling in the billions, and delivered enterprise-wide improvements using **Lean and Six Sigma methodologies**. I am adept at navigating the complexities of political environments with public Boards and building trust with residents, unions, regulatory agencies, and elected officials alike.

Palm Beach County's commitment to innovation, service excellence, and inclusive community impact aligns strongly with my passion for building high-performing, future-ready public institutions. I am energized by the opportunity to serve as your next County Administrator and to lead with vision, integrity, and a relentless focus on results.

*Regarding some of the shorter tenures reflected on my resume, these were directly influenced by industry-wide layoffs (e.g., Tenerity, Cubic, Goodman Solutions), and a tragic mass casualty event at the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority, where 15 lives were lost. These events significantly altered my professional journey and underscore the resilience and adaptability I bring to any leadership role.*
