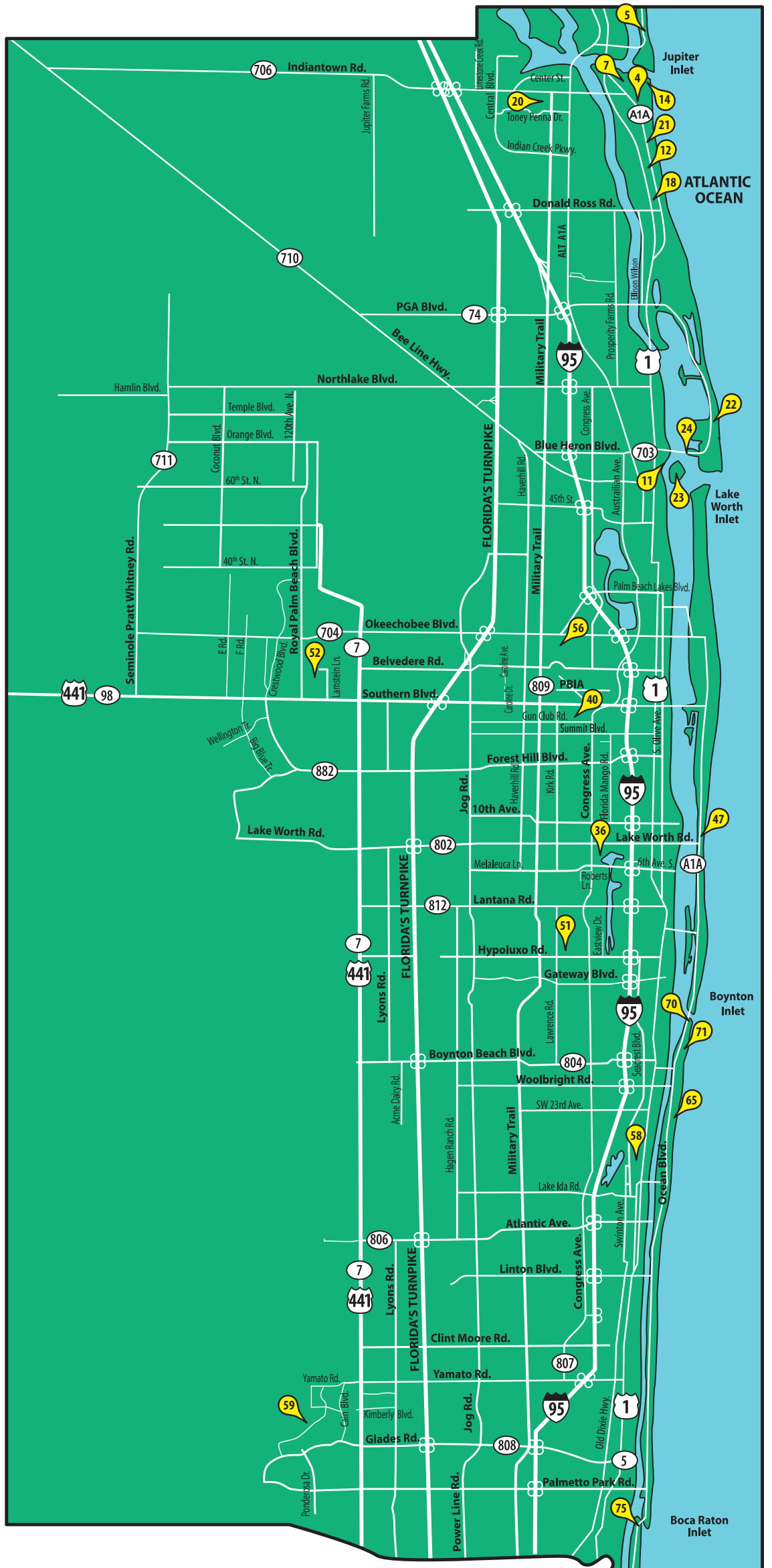
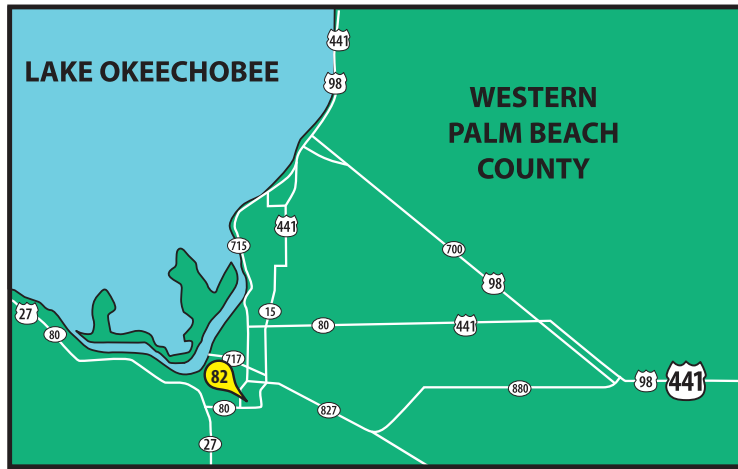


# Where to cool off in PBC Parks



## BEACHES

Palm Beach County's Ocean Rescue lifeguards protect swimmers at fourteen oceanfront and inlet parks from Tequesta to Boca Raton. Swimming areas are guarded when a condition flag is flying from the lifeguard tower at most parks year-round, seven days a week, from 9:00 am – 5:20 pm with exceptions at DuBois Park and Peanut Island. Guard availability may change without notice—look for the condition flag before swimming. For more information on Palm Beach County-operated beaches, please call 561-966-6631.

DuBois Park is guarded seven days a week during Palm Beach County public school summer recess. After school starts, the swimming areas at DuBois Park are guarded **ONLY** on weekends during the public school year. Peanut Island is currently guarded on weekends only.
