Statement of Purpose

Our purpose is to strengthen the prevention and patient care efforts of PrEP & nPEP, HIV testing, engagement in HIV medical care and ART adherence, as well as highlighting the integrity of science over stigma through the promotion of the Undetectable=Untransmittable (U=U) campaign. Through this Redbook, we aim to guide both persons with HIV and providers to connect and form strong partnerships that would light the way toward improved health and wellness. Further, may this directory undergird and unify the diverse HIV care network we have here in Palm Beach County, as we strive to promote and improve the health of all residents.

Preface

The Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resources Emergency (CARE) Act was signed into law on August 18, 1990, and this landmark legislation created the largest federal program focused exclusively on providing care and treatment to people with HIV, called the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP).

In Palm Beach County, there are several Federal and State programs that fund HIV medical care and supportive services and prevention services for those who cannot afford to pay for such care.

The easiest way to find out if someone qualifies for publicly financed HIV services is to contact one of the HIV Case Management Agencies listed in this directory, the Florida Department of Health in Palm Beach County, or the Palm Beach County Department of Community Services.

Today, HIV treatment has improved the quality of life and life expectancy of people with HIV and changed how preventing new infections looks. According to the CDC,

“People with HIV who take HIV medicine as prescribed and get and keep an undetectable viral load (or stay virally suppressed) have effectively no risk of transmitting HIV to their HIV-negative sexual partners.”

The programs, services, and resources provided in this guide are intended to assist people with HIV in improving their health and overall quality of life, and to help those who are negative to remain negative.

EHE

The Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America (EHE) initiative, provides a targeted infusion of new resources and support to local communities in working together and with the federal government to end the HIV epidemic in America. For more information, go to <https://ahead.hiv.gov/>.

According to the Florida Department of Health HIV Section, the overall goal of Florida’s EHE Plan is to decrease the number of HIV transmissions diagnosed annually. The key strategies and activities provided represent unified approaches for the state health department and seven counties (Broward, Duval, Hillsborough, Miami-Dade, Orange, Palm Beach, and Pinellas) listed in phase one of the EHE initiative. Strategies fall into four pillars; Diagnose, Treat, Prevent, and Respond.

“**Diagnose**” strategies include expanding HIV, HCV, and STI screenings, linkage services, and reducing stigma in communities and with providers.

“**Treat**” strategies include enhancing the patient care system, expanding rapid access to care, expanding housing services, and evaluating unmet ancillary services.

“**Prevent**” strategies include increasing testing services available, expanding PrEP access points, implementing social media marketing strategies for PrEP, establishing a nPEP delivery system, and addressing stigma and discrimination.

“Respond” activities include the development of a community level response for HIV transmission networks and communities, engaging and educating providers on current HRSA recommendations to order baseline genotypes for newly diagnosed individuals, and leveraging local level providers to implement a community-level response to transmission networks in areas of high burden.

HIV in Palm Beach County

It is estimated that greater than 85% of Palm Beach County (PBC) residents who are infected with HIV know their status. Our goal through prevention and patient care activities is to reach the remaining persons who are HIV infected but have never tested and have never been linked to medical care.

Of the 9,175 persons confirmed to be living with HIV in Palm Beach County in 2024, at least 6,924 (76%) were on treatment and in medical care. Also, 68% have been retained in care, as defined by PWH with two or more documented VL or CD4 labs, medical visits or prescriptions documented at least three months apart. And 67% have achieved viral load suppression (<200 viral copies/ml blood). These demonstrate an increase of 1% in the care continuum performance, for in care and VL suppression, compared to 2023.

In the last decade, new HIV infections in PBC have increased by 24% -- from 275 in 2015 to 341 in 2024. There were 186 new AIDS diagnoses in 2024, compared to 158 in 2015. And in 2024, Palm Beach County saw 49 HIV-related deaths.

We know how to treat HIV and how to prevent people from being infected. In line with the Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America (EHE) initiative, by 2030, it is our goal to reduce the annual number of new HIV infections in Palm Beach County to fewer than 30 annual cases, a reduction of 90% from the 2020.

This book can serve as a comprehensive directory for anyone seeking HIV prevention or patient care services in Palm Beach County.

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I. MEDICAL SERVICES

RYAN WHITE PROGRAM SERVICES

The Florida Ryan White Part B Program provides services through our 14 lead agencies to eligible clients residing in all counties of Florida. Services are fully funded through the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Extension Act of 2009 administered by the Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB). Ryan White funding fills gaps in care for people living with HIV not covered by other resources.

If you're living with HIV and need help with the costs of your medical care and other services, there are services in Florida that you may be eligible to access.

CORE SERVICES

AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)

State administered FDA-approved medications to low-income individuals with HIV who have limited or no coverage from private insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare.

AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance

Local pharmacy assistance programs to provide HIV medications.

Early Intervention Services (EIS)

Counseling, testing, referrals; clinical and diagnostic services, periodic medical evaluations providing therapeutic measures.

Health Insurance Premium and Cost Sharing Assistance

Financial assistance to maintain a continuity of health insurance or to receive medical benefits under a health insurance program.

Home and Community-Based Health Services

Skilled health services in the home, based on a written plan of care established by a case management team and health care professionals.

Home Health Care

Services in the home by licensed health care workers. Intravenous and aerosolized treatments, parenteral feeding, diagnostic testing, and other medical therapies.

Hospice Services

Room, board, nursing care, counseling, physician services, and palliative therapeutics provided to clients in the terminal stages of illness in a residential setting. Services for physician certified terminal clients having a life expectancy of 6 months or less.

Medical Case Management Services (*including treatment adherence*)

Links clients with health care, psychosocial, and other services, coordination, and follow-up of medical treatments.

Medical Nutrition Therapy

Food and nutritional supplements as required by the plan developed by the dietician.

Mental Health Services

Psychological and psychiatric treatment and counseling services offered to individuals with a diagnosed mental illness.

Oral Health Care

Diagnostic, preventive, and therapeutic services.

Outpatient/Ambulatory Medical Care

Diagnostic and therapeutic services rendered in an outpatient setting. Emergency room services not included.

Substance Abuse Services (*outpatient*)

Treatment and/or counseling to address substance abuse problems in an outpatient setting.

Includes limited acupuncture provided the client has received a written referral from his/her primary health care provider.

SUPPORT SERVICES**Case Management (*non-medical*)**

Assistance in obtaining medical, social, community, legal, financial, and other needed services.

Emergency Financial Assistance

Short-term payments to agencies or establishment of voucher programs to assist with emergency expenses related to essential utilities, housing, food, and medication when other resources are not available.

Food Bank/Home-Delivered Meals

Food, meals, and essential household supplies such as hygiene items and household cleaning supplies.

Health Education/Risk Reduction

Services that educate clients with HIV about HIV transmission and how to reduce the risk of HIV transmission, and counseling to help clients improve their health status.

Housing Services

Short-term assistance to support emergency, temporary or transitional housing to enable an individual or family to gain or maintain medical care.

Legal Services

Powers of attorney, do-not-resuscitate orders, and interventions necessary to ensure access to eligible benefits, including discrimination or breach of confidentiality litigation. Funds may be used for legal services directly necessitated by an individual's HIV serostatus.

Linguistics Services

Interpretation and translation services.

Medical Transportation Services

Conveyance services provided, directly or through voucher so a client may access health care and other Ryan White allowable support services.

Outreach Services

Identification of high-risk communities or individuals with unknown HIV disease or enrolling those who know their status into care and treatment.

Psychosocial Support Services

Support and counseling activities, child abuse and neglect counseling, HIV support groups, pastoral care, caregiver support, and bereavement counseling.

Referral for Health Care/Supportive Services

Directing a client to a service in person or through telephone, written, or other type of communication.

Rehabilitation Services

Physical and occupational therapy, speech pathology, and low vision training in accordance with an individualized plan of care.

Respite Care

Community or home-based, non-medical assistance designed to relieve the primary caregiver responsible for providing day-to-day care of a client with HIV.

Substance Abuse Services (*residential*)

Short-term treatment to address substance abuse problems in a residential health service setting.

Treatment Adherence Counseling

Counseling or special programs to ensure readiness for, and adherence to, complex HIV treatments by non-medical personnel outside of the medical case management and clinical setting.


UNDERSTANDING YOUR LABS

Lab Tests and Why They Are Important

As part of your HIV care, your provider will order laboratory tests. The results of these lab tests, along with your physical exam and other information you provide, will help you and your provider work together to develop the best plan to manage your HIV care so that you can get the virus under control, protect your health, and reduce the chance that you will pass the virus to others.

4th Generation HIV Testing

Fourth-generation HIV tests are immunoassays that test for p24 antigen and IgM and IgG antibodies to HIV-1 and HIV-2 and can detect HIV approximately 14 to 20 days after infection. A positive fourth-generation HIV screen result requires confirmation with an HIV-1/2 antibody differentiation immunoassay. The following graphic displays the routine lab testing algorithm for 4th gen HIV testing.



CD4 Count

CD4 cells are specialized white blood cells of the immune system that are destroyed by HIV. The higher your CD4 cell count, the healthier your immune system. The CD4 count of an uninfected adult/adolescent in good health ranges from 500 cells/mm³ to 1,600 cells/mm³. Fewer than 200/mm³, you are considered to have progressed to stage 3 (AIDS), the most advanced stage of HIV infection.

Viral Load (VL)

An HIV viral load test (HIV RNA test) tracks how many HIV particles are in a sample of your blood. A goal of HIV treatment is to keep your viral load so low that the virus can't be detected by a viral load test.

Undetectable Viral Load

So few copies of the virus are present in the blood that tests are unable to detect them.

Your immune system can recover and become stronger, you have a very low risk of becoming ill because of HIV, and the risk of HIV becoming resistant to the drugs you are taking is very small. Even with an undetectable viral load an HIV positive person still has the virus.

Viral Load Blips

People with an undetectable viral load sometimes experience what are called 'blips' in their viral load. Their viral load increases from undetectable to a low but detectable level before becoming undetectable again on the next test.

Drug Resistance Tests

HIV can change form, making it resistant to some HIV medicines. A drug resistance test helps your provider identify which, if any, HIV medicines will not be effective against the strain of HIV you have.

Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Screening (*screening tests for syphilis, gonorrhea, and chlamydia*)

STDs can cause serious health problems if not treated. Having an STD also can increase your risk of transmitting HIV to others.

Hepatitis A, B, and C Tests

Some people who are living with HIV are also co-infected with hepatitis. Checking you for hepatitis A, B, and C infection can help your provider to determine if you need to be treated, or if you are a candidate for vaccines.

Complete Blood Count (CBC)

Measure of the concentration of red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets in a sample of your blood. It can reveal infections, anemia (abnormality in your red blood cells), and other medical issues.

Fasting Lipid Panel (Cholesterol and Triglycerides)

Lipids are fat or fat-like substances found in the blood and body tissues. These tests measure your lipid levels, including cholesterol and triglycerides.

Some HIV medications can affect your cholesterol levels and the way your body processes and stores fat. High lipids can make you prone to other medical problems, including heart problems.

Fasting Glucose (blood sugar) Test

Measures your blood sugar levels to check for signs of diabetes.

Serum Chemistry Panel

Series of several blood tests that gives your provider information about how your kidneys and liver are working and can be used to evaluate your blood sugar levels, calcium levels, and phosphorous levels.

Other labs your doctor may order:

Tuberculosis Test

Untreated TB can be a deadly disease for people living with HIV. Early screening and treatment will help limit your risk of severe illness, as well as lower your chances of transmitting TB to others.

Toxoplasmosis Screening

Checks for past exposure to a parasite that can cause severe damage to the brain, eyes, and other organs in people with weakened immune systems. Toxoplasmosis can be a deadly opportunistic infection for people living with HIV.

PAP Smear (Cervical and Anal)

Screening test for abnormal cells that could become cancerous. It involves using a swab to take cell samples directly from the cervix and anus.

For women living with HIV, abnormal cell growth in the cervix is common, and abnormal anal cells are common for both men and women living with HIV. These abnormal cells may become cancerous if they aren't treated.

Pregnancy Test

If you are pregnant, you can greatly lower your risk of passing HIV to your baby and protect your own health by taking ART during pregnancy, labor, and delivery.

CLASSIFICATIONS OF ANTIRETROVIRAL DRUGS

NRTIs (NARTIs)

Nucleoside Reverse Transcriptase Inhibitors

Inhibits activity of reverse transcriptase, a viral DNA polymerase that is required for replication of HIV and other retroviruses.

NtRTI

Nucleotide Reverse Transcriptase Inhibitor

Interferes with the HIV life cycle in the same way as NRTIs. Blocks reverse transcription.

NNRTIs

Non-Nucleoside Reverse Transcriptase Inhibitors

Inhibits reverse transcriptase (RT), an enzyme that controls the replication of the genetic material of HIV. Converts HIV genetic material or RNA, into human genetic material or DNA.

PIs

Protease Inhibitors

Inhibits the action of HIV-1 protease, an enzyme that cleaves two precursor proteins into smaller fragments. These fragments are needed for viral growth, infectivity, and replication.

Entry/Fusion Inhibitors

Interferes with the binding, fusion, and entry of an HIV virion to a human cell.

FDC- Fixed Dose Combination

Includes two or more active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) combined in a single dosage form.

FI- Fusion Inhibitor

Works on the outside of the host CD4 cell to prevent HIV from fusing with and infecting it. FIs act by binding to an envelope protein and blocking the structural changes necessary for the virus to fuse with the host CD4 cell.

CCR5 Antagonist

A class of small molecules that antagonize the CCR5 receptor. The C-C motif chemokine receptor CCR5 is involved in the process by which HIV enters cells.

CXCR4 Antagonist

Blocks the CXCR4 co-receptor on the surface of certain immune cells, such as CD4 lymphocytes (CD4 cells). This prevents HIV from entering the cell.

INSTI- Integrase Inhibitor

Blocks the action of integrase, a viral enzyme that inserts the viral genome into the DNA of the host cell.

PE- Pharmacokinetic Enhancer

Used to boost the effectiveness of another drug. When the two drugs are given together, the pharmacokinetic enhancer interferes with the breakdown of the other drug, which allows the drug to remain in the body longer at a higher concentration.

PAI- Post-Attachment Inhibitor

Blocks HIV from binding to the CCR5 and CXCR4 co-receptors after HIV binds to the CD4 receptor on the surface of a CD4 cell. This prevents HIV from entering the cell.

ENDING THE HIV EPIDEMIC (EHE) INITIATIVE

What is the Ending the HIV Epidemic Initiative?

- Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) is a nationwide initiative to end the HIV epidemic in the U.S. by 2030, and Palm Beach County is one of 48 counties in the country selected for Phase 1 of this initiative. The four pillars of EHE are Diagnose, Treat, Prevent and Respond.
- As part of this initiative, the Florida Department of Health in Palm Beach County engaged residents, providers, and community-based organizations (CBO's) to establish an effective EHE workplan with goals and strategies that fall under the four pillars of EHE.
