- IX. VIII. Educational Moments: 2022 Epi Profile Presentation Irma Shute (AREA 9) HIV Surveillance Manager FL-DOH Palm Beach County- 15 Minutes
 - Increasing trends for HIV for year 2021
 - Slight dip in HIV Diagnoses in 2020 before it started increasing again
 - Slide number 4 shows a summary table for 5 years; HIV and Aids are differentiated too
 - PWH by zip code map has not changed much within the past two years
 - Numbers to remember are 50 and 20
 - White Americans represent 50% of the population while only 20% are diagnosed with HIV Aids while Black Americans are about 20% of the population while about 50% have HIV Aids
 - Males make up 73% while the Females make up 27%

- Slight decrease in numbers within the White, Black and Other populations
- Decrease of those transition from HIV to Aids within the Black Community, while there is slight increase in the white and Hispanic Population
- Ages 30-40 are the worst in the increase
- Highest rate of foreign born HIV cases is from Haiti
- o 86% in care, 83% retained in care and 77% viral load suppression
- o In 2022 25% of the males are out of CARE
- Out of care map has not changed much
- A problem area is South Bay
- Will be emailed out to everyone

- Estimate of unmet needs: Estimate of people living with HIV in our jurisdiction who know they have HIV but are not receiving treatment
- Assessment of Service Needs and Barriers: Provides information about the Service needs of people living with HIV both in and out of case
- Resource Inventory: Regularly updated comprehensive listing and description of HIV related services
- o Profile of Provider Capacity and Capability: provides information of service capacity
- Assessment of service needs and gaps: Analysis of Data from all needs assessment components
