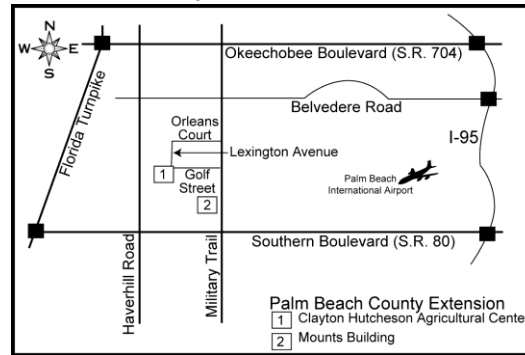

WHY ATTEND PORQUE DEBE ATENDER

The Urban Fertilizer License will be required by January 1, 2014 for anyone commercially applying fertilizer to an urban landscape (and sooner in some jurisdictions). The GI-BMP Certificate of Completion is the prerequisite for this license, and is earned by successfully passing a post-test at the end of the workshop.
