Hi David –

Here are my thoughts on the HHS Element Outline:

I like the general outline format and the 5 objective areas under each domain. Some suggestions:

- Add “Guiding Principles” in the Introduction and include statements, among others, committing to:
 - Collective impact
 - Racial equity
 - Engagement of community residents
 - Provision of services to vulnerable populations, such as Special Needs, LGBTQ, etc.
 - Engagement of the faith-based community in the system of care
- In the Provision of Services Domains:
 - Add Behavioral Health as a Domain
 - Remove Faith-Based and Community as Domains
 - May want to discuss whether the Education Domain includes everything from Early Childhood (child care) to post-secondary; or whether Early Childhood Education should have its own Domain
 - May want to discuss whether the Safety Domain includes protective services for children (Foster Care) and Seniors
- In the Coordination section of each Domain and/or in Implementation, we need to clearly address what the roles/relationships are with:
 - Other County Departments (I think the Element is a great opportunity to provide clarity on this often-confusing-to-the outside-person issue)
 - Related organizations, such as CSC, Health Care District, DOH, United Way, Collective Impact initiative
