



LIHEAP BENEFIT LIMITS INCREASED

Effective April 1, 2020 the LIHEAP benefit limits per household have increased in the following matter:

BENEFIT TYPE	OLD LIMIT	NEW LIMIT
Crisis (Winter and Summer)	Up to \$600	″ Up to \$750
Home Energy	From \$150- \$450	⊄From \$200- \$600

Crisis (Winter and Summer)

• Qualifying households will receive a benefit amount of up to \$750 on a past due bill, to resolve their energy crisis.

Home Energy

- Households that do not have an energy crisis, but whose total income is at or below 150% FPLG, will receive a credit of \$200-\$600.
- The benefit amount will depend on total household income, household composition, and if there are any elderly, disabled or children under age 6 in the household.
