Right to Grieve: Any Proposer may grieve a recommendation for contract award by completing the Grievance Notification Form to the Director, Community Services Department, within seven (7) business days of the posting of the recommended Contract Awards. The grievance shall be submitted and received by the Director of the Community Services Department within seven (7) business days of the posted funding recommendations. You will receive a written response within fifteen (15) business days of the receipt of this form by the Director of the Community Services Department, via hand delivery or mail to 810 Datura Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33401, or email to JGreen1@pbc.gov and reference the subject line: NOFO FY 2026 Grievance. A grievance is considered filed when it is received by the Director, Community Services Department. Failure to file a protest within seven (7) business days of the posting of Recommended Contract Awards shall constitute a waiver of the Proposer's right to grieve.
