Primary Responsibilities:

- Walk trails.
- Perform minimal trash pickup along trails and around parking area/kiosk.
- Monitor brochure boxes and kiosk postings (if applicable).
- Inspect parking area and public use facilities for damage and maintenance concerns.
- Check gates, fencing, and signage for issues or damage.
- Walk perimeter and report any issues or concerns.
- Notify local law enforcement personnel if unlawful activity is occurring.
- Report hours and observations weekly via email to the Site Steward Coordinator or through a phone application (training provided).

Related Responsibilities as Needed:

- Attend ongoing educational opportunities and presentations.
- Assist ERM staff with volunteer workdays; one to four per year, such as cleanups, restoration projects, exotic control, etc.
- Assist in data collection, monitor resources, and document plant and animal sightings.

Desired Experience or Qualifications:

- Enjoys being outdoors in nature.
- Familiar with local plant and animal species.
- Basic computer skills, such as emailing, or willingness to learn a smart phone application.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
