

Public Shoot Range Rules

All persons wishing to use these facilities **MUST** read and initial each item and sign below

Initials

- All persons, including non-shooting spectators and minors, **MUST** register at the office and sign a liability waiver for each visit to the facility.
- Range safety officers (Red Shirts) will monitor and direct all activity on the firing line, their directions **MUST** be followed at all times. Range Officers have the authority to remove anyone who violates range safety rules or otherwise causes disruption or distraction of other shooters. Range Officers also have the authority to remove any weapon from the line that is not functioning properly or that they otherwise deem unsafe.
- We operate using the Hot / Cold line concept. When the Range Officer calls the line "Cold", all weapons **MUST** be benched with the action open and visible with the safety in the on position. If the weapon has a removable magazine, it must be removed from the weapon. If available a flag should be placed in the breach. **There will be absolutely NO handling of weapons when the line is COLD.** When the line is HOT, no one will proceed beyond the firing line for any reason.
- All shooters **MUST** wear Ear and Eye protection when ever the line is HOT. Spectators **MUST** wear Ear protection. Open toed shoes (flip flops / sandals) are not permitted on the firing line. Hats are suggested.
- All weapons **MUST** be transported to the firing line securely encased and unloaded with the actions open and safety on. **Loading will ONLY be allowed on the firing line.** Only one firearm will be allowed on the bench at a time.
- Firearms are limited to Rifles, Shotguns (Slugs Only), and black powder guns in calibers generally used for hunting or sporting events. Fully automatic weapons or .50 Caliber rifles are not permitted. **Handguns are Not** permitted on the range at any time regardless of concealed weapons permit, handguns **Must** be secured in the vehicle.
- No** steel core, armor piercing, tracer, exploding, or incendiary ammunition is permitted on the range. Range Officers are permitted to inspect any ammunition to ensure safety and preserve range integrity.
- Smoking, spitting tobacco, and eating are **NOT** permitted while on the firing line. Smoking is not permitted while under the cover at either bay. Please be courteous to others and step away to smoke.
- Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted** at the Firearms Facility and anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or other substances will be removed from the Range
