## **Special Session & Committee Week 4**

November 6-9, 2023

## **Special Session C**

On October 20, Senate President Kathleen Passidomo and House Speaker Paul Renner issued a joint proclamation convening a special session during the committee week scheduled for November 6-9. The following four bills were passed by the legislature and subsequently signed into law by the Governor.

**HB 1C, Disaster Relief:** This legislation provides additional resources to assist Floridians recovering from the impacts of Hurricane Idalia, including tax relief on motor fuel used for agricultural shipments and debris removal, as well as on materials used to repair or replace nonresidential farm buildings and fencing. The bill also addresses the backlog of My Safe Florida Home applications by allocating \$176.2 million to the program, allowing Floridians to fortify their homes and lower their insurance premiums. Lastly, the bill revised an existing prohibition on local governments within 100 miles of the landfall of Hurricanes Ian or Nicole from proposing or adopting more restrictive or burdensome procedures or amendments concerning a development order, land development regulation, or comprehensive plan. With the new law taking effect upon the Governor's signature, this prohibition now only applies to specified counties impacted by Hurricane Ian (not including PBC) and municipalities within those counties.

**HB 3C, Family Empowerment Scholarship:** The bill revises the cap for the Family Empowerment Scholarship Program for Students with Unique Abilities so that eligible students can access the educational resources that fit their individual needs.

**HB 5C, Scrutinized Companies:** This legislation directs the State Board of Administration to divest public funds from companies on the "Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Iran Terrorism Sectors List" that do business with the Islamic Republic of Iran in specific sectors. The bill was sponsored by Representative John Snyder, a member of the Palm Beach County Legislative Delegation.

**HB 7C, Security Grants:** The bill provides at-risk institutions, such as Jewish Day Schools, with additional security resources and infrastructure.

Both the House and Senate adopted resolutions in support of the State of Israel during the special session as well.

Senator Lori Berman, who represents a portion of Palm Beach County, sponsored **SR 8C** condemning the attack on October 7 by Hamas and supporting the right of Israel to exist as a sovereign nation. It also supports Israel's right to defend itself, demands the end of financial support to Iranian-backed Hamas or other entities that support such terrorist organizations, and condemns threats against Jewish people, institutions, and communities. The resolution was adopted with unanimous support.

The Florida House adopted two similar resolutions to that of the Senate. In a show of bipartisan support, Representative Katharine Waldron and Representative Peggy Gossett-Seidman of the Palm Beach County Legislative Delegation, joined together to sponsor **HR 9C** which asserts Florida's unwavering support of Israel and condemns the terrorist organization Hamas. Representative Randy Fine sponsored the second adopted resolution, **HR 11C**, that called for the U.S. to halt funding for Palestinian-affiliated organizations and condemned anti-Semitic rhetoric on college campuses and elsewhere.
