I. Call to Order

II. Adoption of February 21, 2024, Agenda

MOTION to adopt the agenda. Motion by Brenda Znachko, seconded by Irwin Jacobowitz, and carried 6-0.

III. Approval of February 7, 2024, Minutes

MOTION to approve the February 7, 2024, minutes. Motion by Keith Clinkscale, seconded by Brenda Znachko, and carried 6-0.

IV. Review of Projects

 Project No. 2017517 Florida Mango Rd., Barbados Rd. to North of Myrica Rd. – ENG

Amount: \$587.000

Ms. Knight stated that the IFB was for a project to replace a culvert at the L-7 canal. EPW proposed an SBE Mandatory Minimum Subcontracting Goal of 20 percent.

Angela Smith said that OEBO agreed with the proposal with the additional provision that 5 percent of the 20 percent Mandatory Minimum Subcontracting Goal be MBE African American- or Hispanic American-owned firms.

Ms. Knight stated that EPW agreed with the provision.

MOTION to adopt the SBE Subcontracting Mandatory Minimum of 20 percent with 5 percent of the mandatory minimum to be African American or Hispanic American-owned firms. Motion by Irwin Jacobowitz, seconded by Brenda Znachko, and carried 7-0.

2. Project No. 2024055 Civil Engineering Professional Consulting Services – ENG Amount: \$3,300,000

Ms. Knight stated that EPW was disseminating an RFP for a CCNA Professional Services contract for civil engineering services. The proposal had been tabled at the January meeting. She explained that she had conducted an analysis of CCNA certification and commodity codes to determine vendor availability. Based on that analysis, EPW recommended an SBE Mandatory Minimum Subcontracting Goal of 20 percent with an SBE Evaluation Preference for Prime Bidders.

Angela Smith said that OEBO agreed with the 20 percent Mandatory Minimum Subcontracting Goal with the addition of an MWBE Evaluation Preference of up to 15 points for African American-owned firms.

Discussion ensued regarding EPW's proposal and the methodology used to calculate vendor availability.

(CLERK'S NOTE: Melody Thelwell joined the meeting as an attendee.)

Discussion continued, and Ms. Knight responded to questions about the nature of the projects encompassed by the contract.

Ms. Knight suggested a modified recommendation of an SBE Mandatory Minimum Subcontracting Goal of 20 percent, of which 5 percent would be MBE African Americanowned firms, and an SBE Evaluation Preference.

Angela Smith stated that OEBO agreed with the recommendation.

MOTION to apply the recommended API of SBE Mandatory Minimum Subcontracting Goal of 20 percent, of which 5 percent would be MBE African

American, and apply the SBE Evaluation Preference for SBE Participation. Motion by Brenda Znachko, seconded by Keith Clinkscale, and carried 7-0.

3. Palm Tran Uniform Program – PALM Amount: \$900,000

Ms. Byrd stated that Palm Tran proposed to contract with a vendor on a three-year basis with two one-year renewal options. The contract would include provision of professional uniform garments, accessories, and shoes as well as embroidery and alteration services. Palm Tran recommended an SBE Evaluation Preference for Prime Bidders.

Mr. Newton said that OEBO agreed with the recommendation.

Discussion ensued regarding the details of the contract.

MOTION to apply the recommended API of SBE Evaluation Preference for Prime Bidders. Motion by Brenda Znachko, seconded by Ryan Maher, and carried 7-0.
