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# The Enterprise

The Mission of the Office of Equal Business Opportunity (OEBO) is to ensure that all local small businesses have an equitable opportunity to participate in the County's procurement process. Our purpose is to work with all County departments to provide support and technical assistance while promoting the economic growth, expansion and increased productivity of all small, minority and women owned business enterprises in accordance with the established ordinance, policies and procedures.

The OEBO aims to continually assist local S/M/WBEs to further improve their business capacity by increasing their presence within the Palm Beach County vendor pool through increased certifications within various commodity types. The OEBO has found that there is a significant deficit between the amount of certified S/M/WBE vendors providing goods/services within specific commodity areas and the demand of departments within Palm Beach County.

In order to remedy this deficiency, the OEBO will be providing information designed to inform the vendor community and the public of the current commodity codes that Palm Beach County uses to solicit contracts that currently lack sufficient S/M/WBE participation resulting in waivers of Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) being granted. While the County is not required to do so, we believe providing this information will foster full and open competition among all available vendors registered with Palm Beach County and encourage S/M/WBE vendors to pursue certification for the commodities where deficits are present.

### **Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department**

The Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department is committed to increasing opportunities for small, minority and women business owners. The Department works closely with the Office of Equal Business Opportunity to ensure as many qualified vendors as possible are fulfilling its purchasing needs. Recognized at the state and national levels for excellence in park and recreation management, the department operates more than 110 parks and recreational facilities and provides organized recreational programs and services for people of all ages and abilities. Understanding the department's mission and services will assist you in determining if you or someone you know are able to provide the Department with goods and services.



#### Background

Parks and Recreation employs 590 permanent positions and has a general operating budget of about \$78 million. Their mission is to provide opportunities for healthy, happy living through award-winning parks, inclusive experiences and environmental stewardship. The department offers the widest possible range of leisure opportunities serving millions of park visitors each year. Services include:

- public safety;
- grounds maintenance;
- recreation programs;
- specialized facilities that include;
  - aquatic centers
  - community centers
  - nature centers
  - golf courses
  - fishing piers
  - equestrian centers
  - amphitheaters
  - athletic fields and courts
  - boating facilities
  - beaches
  - historical and cultural museums.



The department's core values focus on: a culture of teamwork by showing respect, trust, tolerance, fairness and a positive attitude toward co-workers in a diverse working environment; excellent customer service by meeting the needs of our community with healthy, happy living experiences through leadership, training, resource allocation, innovation and customer focus; demonstrating a high level of integrity and pride through open, honest and respectful communication with customers and co-workers, and providing quality recreational opportunities; and being fiscally responsible and accountable by providing sound fiscal policies and procedures, measuring and validating performance, and being good stewards of our resources.



### **Opportunities**

With the passage of the One Penny Sales tax, the Parks and Recreation Department was allocated approximately \$125 million that is being used to finance the renewal and replacement of many park amenities. Sales Tax projects moving forward this year include:

- Lake Lytal Pool replacement project;
- various park playground replacements;
- park pathway and parking lot repairs;
- athletic field renovations;
- sports lighting replacement;
- septic system replacements.

In addition to capital construction projects, in FY 2018 the Parks and Recreation Department spent over \$25 million in operating expenses. Items purchased include:

- \$850,000 in contractual services for grounds maintenance, janitorial services, and pest control;
- \$600,000 for recreational instructors;
- \$4.8 million in other contractual services including golf course management and maintenance contracts;
- \$350,000 in general operating supplies;
- \$175,000 in recreation supplies;
- \$200,000 in food and beverage resale items;
- \$175,000 in uniforms;
- \$82,000 in power and hand held tools;
- \$400,000 on insecticides and pesticides.


### 2019 Business MatchMaker Conference and Expo

The Palm Beach Partners hosted its 13th Annual Business MatchMaker Conference and Expo on September 20 at the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts and included over 300

### **Information Systems Services**

**Information Systems Services (ISS)** serves as the primary information technology (IT) support agency for most of the departments reporting to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as the independently elected constitutional officers of Palm Beach County. ISS is also a growing service provider to non-County agencies (government, education, health care and nonprofit) in the areas of network connectivity, internet service, data center colocation, hosting services, and document scanning. Internet access to County information, services, and systems have expanded the Department's customer base to include not only County employees, business partners, taxpayers, and citizens, but also the public at large.

Palm Beach County Information Systems Services (ISS) serves as an important partner in the promotion of Small, Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (S/M/WBE) participation in county government business. Below are some of the services which ISS provides that helps the OEBO accomplish its mission.

- 1. Application Services
  - a. Partners with the EBO Office in acquiring, through purchase or in-house development, specialized software applications that support the business operations.
  - b. Provide maintenance and support of the award-winning EBO public website.
  - c. Develop vital business outreach surveys.
  - d. Develop and support the department essential software applications for the EBO Office.
  - e. EBO Vendor Portal and Administration System for online vendor S/M/WBE certification, renewal, and participation compliance.
  - f. Vendor Search Directory for searching EBO certified vendors and their commodities/services.
  - g. CINEMA for scanning, indexing, storing and retrieving of OEBO documents in digitized form.

#### 2. Network Services

- a. Assures cost-effective, high-speed, stable network and communications environment interconnecting the EBO Office with other Palm Beach County agencies, constitutional offices, other local and state government agencies, and the public.
- b. Maintains converged voice and data networks via Voice over IP (VoIP) solutions to deliver modern communications functions and control costs.
- 3. Platform Services
  - a. Maintains critical OEBO enterprise systems that include application and database hosting, desktop support, data storage and recovery, a comprehensive security program; operation of a 24x7 enterprise-wide help desk, network printing, and providing web access to employees, citizens and business partners.
  - b. Provide technical support at periodic EBO outreach events.
- 4. Finance and Administration Services.
  - a. Assists with the procurement and warranty servicing of OEBO IT equipment.

## Become Pre-Qualified!!!

Pre-qualification contracts are a great opportunity for new or existing vendors to bid smaller projects in order to become familiar with the County's processes and to establish a solid working relationship with the County!

A pre-qualification contract is a contract that includes minimum qualifications (e.g., references, licenses, experience, etc.) required from the vendor in order for them to become pre-qualified on a contract for goods and/or services where two or more qualified vendors compete for specific projects. The County will add vendors to the pre-qualification contract at any time as long as the vendor meets the minimum qualifications stated in the pre-qualification package. Purchases solicited through a pre-qualification contract are generally under \$100,000.

Palm Beach County's Purchasing and Facilities Development & Operations Departments have an assortment of pre-qualification contracts available for a variety of different services that are utilized by multiple departments within Palm Beach County. 
