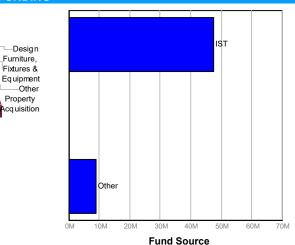

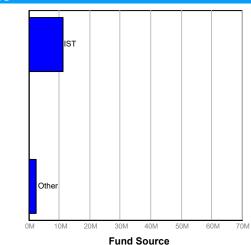

Phase 1 of the project was divided into Phase 1A and Phase 1B. Phase 1A is substantially complete and includes bulkhead wall replacement, municipal dock and boat lifts replacement, and installation of a floating day-use dock. Safety concerns with the floating dock remain unresolved, preventing progress on Phase 1B, which involves installing a main floating marina dock and wave attenuator. The contractor has submitted a final pay application, but it cannot be processed until unapproved change proposals are resolved. Per Parks and Recreation's request, Phase 1B and Phase II are currently on hold until the floating dock safety issues are addressed.
