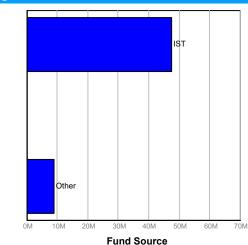

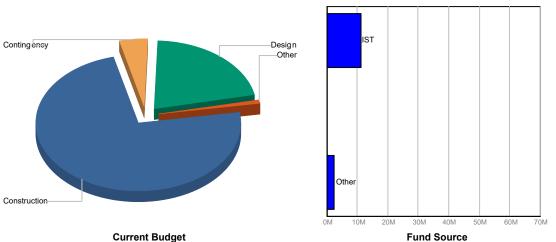

Phase 1 of the project was divided into two sub phases, Phase 1 A and Phase 1B. Phase 1A, which is substantially complete, consists of the bulkhead wall replacement, municipal dock and boat lifts replacement, and installation of a floating day use dock. There is safety concerns with the floating day use dock that has yet to be resolved which, until resolved, prevents moving forward with Phase 1B. Phase 1B consists of the installation of a main floating marina dock, and a wave attenuator. Resolution of the latest pay application and pending change order requests is in process. Phase 1B and Phase II of the project is on hold, until the safety concerns with the floating docks are resolved.
