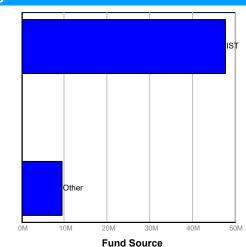

Exterior work in progress continues or will commence shortly, such as new exterior camera wiring, parking lot sealing, final roof inspection, civil/ landscape final inspection, etc. The punch-out effort will begin in mid-April 2023. Owner acceptance and turnover are still expected in mid-July 2023.
