Zyscovich, LLC was competitively selected to provide professional master site planning, programming, investigation design, interior space planning, engineering, permitting and construction administration services for site redevelopment. The needs assessment and conceptual plans have been completed and the August 29, 2023 BCC Workshop concluded with direction to proceed with Option 1 contingent upon a satisfactory funding plan. Efforts on a funding plan and parking needs study are in progress.
