#### Four Type 1 Transfers

- Lake Ida West Septic System Replacement (\$60,349)
- Okeeheelee Caretakers Septic System Replacement (\$35,320)
- Caloosa Septic System Replacement (\$36,784)
- Morikami Septic System Replacement (\$48,966)

Total of \$181,419 to be transferred to Parks Reserves

#### 3 Type 2 Transfers

- Okeeheelee Park Street and Parking Light Replacement (+\$211,000)
- Dyer Park Athletic Field Renovations (+\$992,581)
- Westgate Park Restroom and Athletic Field Renovations (+\$154,460)

Total of \$1,358,041 to be transferred <u>from</u> Parks Surtax Reserves to cover project shortfalls.

Remaining Parks Reserve Balance of \$412,994.

#### Six Type 3 Transfers

- Buttonwood Park Athletic Field Renovation (+\$1,843,078)
- Caloosa Park Athletic Field Renovation (+\$2,621,357)
- Samuel Friedland District Park Expansion (+\$2,830,109)
- Glades Pioneer Park Athletic Field Renovation (+\$2,676,038)
- Loggers Run Park Athletic Field Renovation (+\$916,889)
- West Boynton Park Athletic Field Renovation (+\$1,935,497)

Total of \$12,822,968 to be transferred <u>from</u> County Surtax Reserves to cover project shortfalls.

Remaining County Reserve Balance of \$18,283,007.

# Parks Budget Transfers



- Reasons for shortfall:
  - High subcontractor costs (labor)
  - Materials costs remain high
  - Location costs
  - Shortfalls are not scope related
- Projected Build Schedule:
  - Oct. Jan. 2024: Loggers Run, Caloosa and Westgate
  - Jan. April 2025: Buttonwood, Glades Pioneer
  - May Aug. 2025: Sam Friedland, West Boynton, Dyer
  - Under Design John Prince Miracle League Field
- Build time of 90 to 150 days per park.
- Installation timed to coincide with low field usage.
