Phase I calls for the interior design of floors 10, 11 and 12 along with supporting infrastructure (electrical, HVAC, data and plumbing), elevator upgrades, and the exterior items such as impact glazing, up-lighting, façade improvements and reroofing the seven roofs of the facility. The design work is anticipated to take a year. We are initiating a CSA #5 to address space modifications under the Parking Garage to provide transitional space for a smaller department within the Phase I work. This work may require updating the Heat Pump HVAC and Cooling Tower.
