Pretest PRETEST MUST BE COMPLETED FOR CLASS PARTICIPATION

- 1. Must be 15 years old on or before the final scheduled session of this course.
- 2. Complete a swim-tread-swim sequence without stopping to rest: Jump into the water and totally submerge, resurface then swim 150 yards using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both (Swimming on the back or side is not permitted, goggles are allowed), Then maintain position at the surface of the water for 2 minutes by treading water using only the legs, floating, or both, then swim 50 yards using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both.
- 3. Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds.
