Getting Started with Volunteering

General requirements for volunteering:

- Volunteers must be at least fifteen years old.
- Volunteers must not need court-ordered service hours.
- Volunteers must commit to working at least two hours per week for a minimum of six months.
- Volunteers must complete the application process.

The first step in the process is for us to meet to discuss your interests, time availability, and the center's needs. After the meeting, you will complete an application, and a background screening will be done. Once you are cleared to begin volunteering, you will be trained by staff and ready to get started!
