Jim Brandon Equestrian Center Covered Arena Open Riding

The Covered Arena will be open on designated dates and times during the summer for general purpose riding.

The two (2) rings in the Open Riding Area and the Trails will remain open from sunrise to sunset daily.

All users are hereby advised that this area is an unsupervised recreational area and that the use of this facility is at their own risk.

Failure to comply will all Park rules and regulations may result in the revocation of privileges.

Additional Rules and Regulations:

- Covered Arena hours will be from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm on designated dates which will be posted on the JBEC website, Facebook and Park bulletin boards or call 561 966-7090.
- Open to individual riders for general purpose riding which is limited to walk trot and canter.
- No lessons, camp, clinics or any type of equipment or obstacles can be placed in the arena.
- Riders must carry proof of horse's current negative Coggins test and provide it upon request and comply will all regulations of the State of Florida Animal Health Division.
- Riders 16 years of age and under are required to wear an approved safety helmet in accordance with "Nicole's Law" regardless of riding style and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- No lunging, bareback riding, riding double or "ponying" of horses.
- Riders cannot deny another rider the use of the arena.
- All vehicles must enter at Gate 3.
- All trailers must be parked in the grass parking area south of the barns.
- Horses must be attended at all times and are not permitted to be turned out in any arena or housed in barns. Horses must not be tied to fences, trees, pavilions, equipment, gates, or barns.
- Riders are responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of the area and trash must be placed in the proper receptacles, including recycle bins.
- Horses are to be washed in designated wash racks. Hoses are not provided.
- Any horse known to display harmful behavior (like kicking or biting) must wear a red ribbon in its tail to alert other riders.
- The facility will not be open during inclement weather.

Under Florida law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. Florida Statute 773.02.
