- Birds

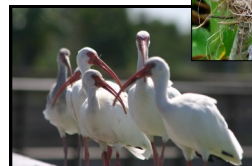
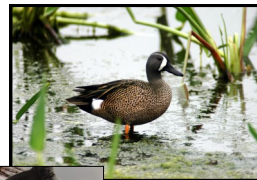


# Birds

# Exotic Animals

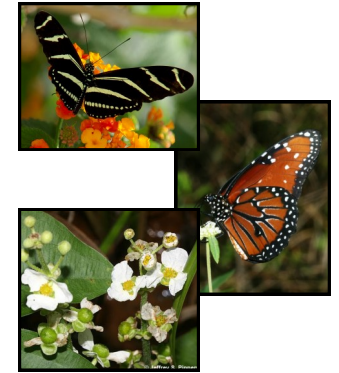
