The A4AFL Holiday Showcase is an annual public event that presents the performing talents of individuals with disabilities. It encompasses 8 - 10 performing groups or individuals from Palm Beach County. The populations represented are those with mental, physical and emotional disabilities of all ages.

Performers at various stages within their craft are welcome to the showcase. Those who are just beginning experience the thrill of performing on stage. Others who have performed before are able to advance their art in a supportive environment.

The showcase affords artists with disabilities a forum to present their talents on a professional stage assisted by a professional crew.

The Benefits

The Showcase serves more than 700 people which include: performers, their families and the general public and involves nearly 100 volunteers, theatre personnel and the media.

Families comprise the core audience at the Showcase. Families experience an outing to the theatre where the show is centered around the talent and ability of their family member. In addition, families and performers are invited to a reception which is hosted between afternoon rehearsals and the evening performance. Professionally catered, this reception honors the performers and their families giving them a chance to relax during this busy day.

Impact and Results: The performers acquire various physical, social, cognitive and behavioral skills throughout the process of developing, practicing and executing artistic performances. The event presents families the opportunity to showcase the strengths, talents and determination of their family members. Success of the showcase will be measured by the size and scope of the audience, quality of the performance, evaluations by performing arts professionals and randomly distributed survey.
