





**PALM BEACH COUNTY FIRE RESCUE

EMPLOYMENT APPLICATION GUIDE TO REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS**

**Applications are ONLY accepted when there  
is an active job listing on [www.PBCGOV.jobs](http://www.PBCGOV.jobs)**

The four following **REQUIRED** certifications must be current/valid and uploaded to the application at time of submission:

REQUIRED CERTIFICATION	EXAMPLE* OF DOCUMENT
<p>Florida <i>Firefighter Certificate of Compliance</i> (from the State of Florida Bureau of Fire Standards and Training)</p>	
<p>Florida <i>Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)</i> certification <b>OR</b> Florida <i>Paramedic (PMD)</i> certification</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> National Registry EMT certification <b>will not</b> be accepted</p>	
<p>Certification/Authentication Letter of having passed an IAFF-sanctioned <i>Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT)</i> within 1 year of job listing closing date (as specified in advertisement)*</p>	
<p>Certification of having passed a 16-hour <i>Emergency Vehicle Operator Course (EVOC)</i>*</p>	

\*Document appearance/format may vary by vendor

**NOTE:** Failure to submit the required certifications with the application will result in disqualification from the selection process. Be sure to follow the application instructions included in the job advertisement.
