The Missing-in-America Project locates the remains of Veterans who never received a proper burial, and inters them with Full Honors at the South Florida National Cemetery. PBCFR Honor Guard and Pipes & Drums has been a part of that for many years, escorting the urns to their final resting place. Some Veterans' remains had been unclaimed for 40+ years and were found in funeral home storage closets.

The year 2019, with 62 events, was the most active in the history of the Honor Guard. We could not have reached that total without the level of support we are afforded from PBCFR Administration and Local 2928. So with that, we say a sincere **thank you**.

Again this year, PBCFR Honor Guard members had primary roles in the planning and command of multi-agency personnel for the Fire Chiefs' Association of Palm Beach County's September 11th Remembrance Ceremony.

Additionally, we were called upon to assist in lead roles in the planning, support and unit command for funerals of personnel from Boynton Beach FR, Martin County FR and Palm Beach Gardens FR. It is an honor that we have become a dependable resource for our fellow Fire Service agencies in their time of need.

PBCFR Honor Guard has, over the years, established ourselves as a fixture at the Florida Fallen Firefighter Memorial in Ocala, typically having one of the largest contingents in attendance of any department in the State. This has afforded us the opportunity to have key roles in the ceremony and command structure year after year.

Also important to note, is that PBCFR Video Production Unit has produced the official Fallen Firefighter Ceremony video for the State Fire Marshall's Office for the past 10-12 years.

Mario Pico became an Honor Guard Candidate in March. He was promoted to full-member status in September while in Colorado for the IAFF Memorial. The presentation of his Member-Only challenge coin made it official.

The Honor Guard Candidate Program provides interested potential members the opportunity to learn first-hand what the Honor Guard does at ceremonies and events. There is a certain level of commitment to be a member, so it provides a chance to see if it is something that works for them.

Recruitment of new Honor Guard members is a priority for the start of the new year. There are 14 members now, and our goal is to get to 20 active members in the next few years.

The Honor Guard and Pipes & Drums represented Palm Beach County at events with national and international audiences such as The 33rd Annual Governor's Hurricane Conference, The Association of Inspector Generals' Conference, The Lincoln Day Dinner at Mar-a-Lago, The Palm Beach County Democratic Club Annual Dinner, to name a few.

The events we are asked to participate in are as varied as Recruit Graduations, Promotional Ceremonies, funerals and memorials, service-area HOA events, Awards Ceremonies, parades, Change of Command Ceremonies and the Honor Flight Homecoming ceremonies with Honor Flag presentations at PBIA.

Requests for service come from PBCFR Administration, Board of County Commissioners, family members of deceased Firefighters and civic leaders within our service-area communities.

2019 Annual Report



The Palm Beach County Firefighters Pipes and Drums is Southeast Florida's oldest fire service pipe band. Established in September 2001, we have been playing for both Public Safety and civic events in and around Southeast Florida for the past 18 years. We are proud that our entire band is open to any Firefighter, active or retired, living in, or serving in Palm Beach County.

Our band currently has 12 members. We come from Palm Beach County Fire Rescue, West Palm Beach Fire Rescue and Delray Beach Fire Rescue. Our 6 bagpipers are led by Pipe Major and founding member John Flynn (retired Battalion Chief, PBCFR). The 6 member drum corps is led by Drum Sergeant Ed Peek (Driver/Operator, PBCFR). Our band manager is founding member Jon Ferguson (Driver/Operator, PBCFR). We currently have one bagpipe and 2 bass drum students that have been practicing hard. We hope they become permanent, kilned members of the band in 2020.

2019 has been a prolific year for the band. We met 102 times. 70 times were for requested events across the region and the nation. We also held 32 practices at PBCFR Headquarters. Tenor Drummer Lelani Kamalu (Lt. PBCFR) played the most gigs from our drum line, and Piper Tom Reyes (Captain, PBCFR) was tops in attendance for the Bagpipes.

We played for 7 Fire Rescue graduations, 12 funerals, 6 Change of Command Ceremonies, 4 retirement parties, and marched in 3 parades. We have played for military veterans, prominent government officials, and civic organizations serving at local, state and national levels multiple times this year.

In 2019, our band traveled to Colorado Springs, CO for the IAFF Fallen Firefighter Memorial as well as Ocala, FL for the Florida Fallen Firefighter Memorial. We played in Savanna, GA and Boston, MA. It was especially humbling when Martin County Fire reached out to us to be the lead band for MCFR FF/PM Neumann's LODD funeral, held in Vero Beach, FL. Not only did we send 7 members to render honors that afternoon, we also had 8 members play for the opening of the 2019 PBCFR Promotional Ceremony that same evening in Lake Worth.

Over the years we have developed close relationships with other bands across the country. We maintained and grew those relationships this year. We played with The Black Pearl Pipes and Drums (Broward/Dade County), The Greater Boston Firefighters Pipes and Drums (Boston, MA), and the Orange County Fire Authority Pipes and Drums (Orange County, CA). We were at the 2019 Keeping Tradition Alive Pipes and Drums Symposium in Lewisville, Texas.

We would like to acknowledge and thank the leadership of PBCFR, WPBFR, Delray Beach Fire Rescue along with IAFF Local 2928 for their support of the band and their continual role in helping the band render honors and respect back to our community. Their continued assistance is invaluable in allowing us to maintain and showcase the traditions, values and spirit of the fire service across southeast Florida and the country.
