THINGS TO KNOW....

- **The Pet Friendly Shelter (PFS) is available to Palm Beach County residents residing in a mandatory evacuation zone or in mobile homes.** Proof of residency is required. Space is limited and restrictions apply. The shelter can accommodate dogs, cats, birds and small pocket pets. Livestock, reptiles and exotic pets will not be accepted. **Pet owners may not stay at the Pet Friendly Shelter with their pets.** Owners can shelter at Park Vista High School, which is located next door to the PFS.
- Pet Friendly Shelter admission will be consistent with other shelter openings.
- Pet owners that are pre-registered with the Emergency Management Special Needs facility at the Fairgrounds can pre-register their pets to stay at the Pet Friendly Shelter. There is limited space available.
- Dogs and cats must be microchipped, currently vaccinated against rabies and wearing a current license tag.
- All pets must have a kennel or carrier large enough for the animal to stand and turn around, space for two bowls, and a litter box for cats. Owners must provide pet's food (for at least five days), medications, treats, bedding, toys, and a blanket, sheet or towel large enough to cover the kennel/carrier/crate.
- For the safety of staff and other animals, we reserve the right to refuse admission to animals which are displaying aggression. No animals classified as Aggressive, Dangerous or Potentially Dangerous or registered guard dogs will be accepted.
- Once the storm has passed, the Pet Friendly Shelter will be immediately closed. You will be notified by text and/or email that the shelter has closed and that your pet must be picked up by their owner or authorized caretaker. All pets must be picked up within three (3) hours of notification.
- Animals not picked up within three hours after the shelter has closed will be impounded into the main shelter at 7100 Belvedere Road, West Palm Beach. **All impounds will incur fees.**
