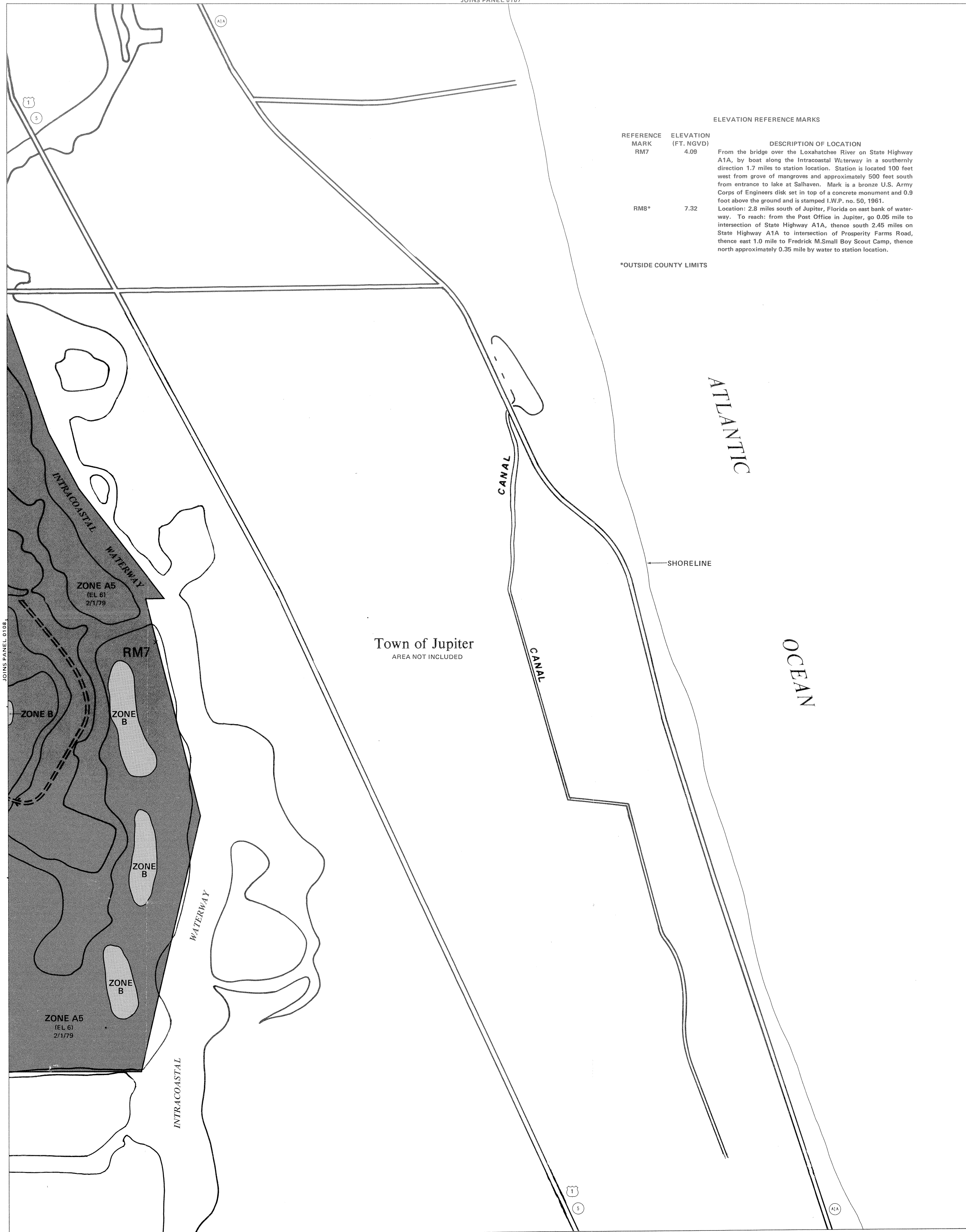

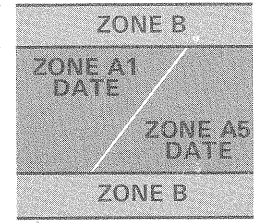
ELEVATION REFERENCE MARKS

REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION (FT. NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM7	4.09	From the bridge over the Loxahatchee River on State Highway A1A, by boat along the Intracoastal Waterway in a southerly direction 1.7 miles to station location. Station is located 100 feet west from grove of mangroves and approximately 500 feet south from entrance to lake at Salhaven. Mark is a bronze U.S. Army Corps of Engineers disk set in top of a concrete monument and 0.9 foot above the ground and is stamped L.W.P. no. 50, 1961.
RM8*	7.32	Location: 2.8 miles south of Jupiter, Florida on east bank of waterway. To reach: from the Post Office in Jupiter, go 0.05 mile to intersection of State Highway A1A, thence south 2.45 miles on State Highway A1A to intersection of Prosperity Farms Road, thence east 1.0 mile to Fredrick M.Small Boy Scout Camp, thence north approximately 0.35 mile by water to station location.

\*EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.

NOTES TO USER

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.  
 This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas.

 Coastal base flood elevations shown on this map include the effects of wave action.

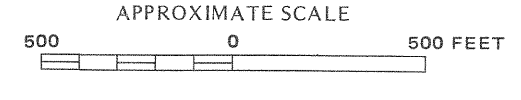
