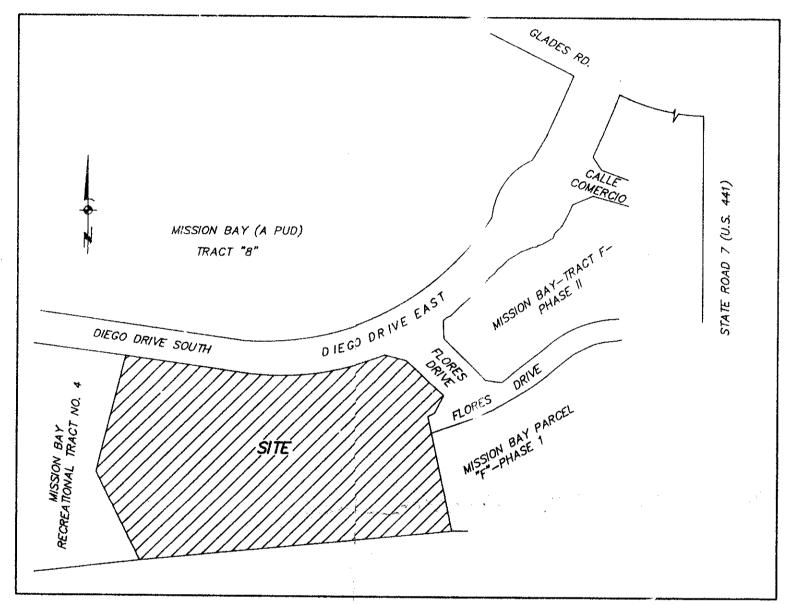
1. EASEMENTS
