Summary: Proposed is an amendment for the 19.46-acre Busch Wildlife Sanctuary Foundation development. The site was last approved by the Board of County Commissioners on April 22, 2021 to allow the Institutional Nonprofit Assembly use.

The proposed request will modify Engineering Condition of Approval related to the construction of a minimum eight-foot wide pathway along the west side of Rocky Pines Road from Indiantown Road to the south property line. In addition, the Applicant is also requesting modifications to the Site Plan relating to the layout of the animal exhibits and the internal pedestrian pathways. No other modifications are proposed and access will remain from Rocky Pines Road.
