



ANNUAL PERMIT and RANDOM INSPECTIONS of Residential Water heater and A/C change outs

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ONLINE DECAL A/C AND PLUMBING CONTRACTORS –

As Decal Online registration fees are non-refundable, before you finish the registration process, take a moment to review your license and permit status by going to <https://discover.pbcgov.org/pzb/Pages/default.aspx> - Online Services - Building Activities. From there, click the tab CONTRACTOR and enter the license number you are registering.

Looking below, the Status is currently showing ACTIVE. At this point, you should research your COMPLETE status permits, as well as your INACTIVE status permits.

In order to be authorized to the program, contractors must have a minimum of ten (10) permits pulled and completed. Contractors must also have no more than five (5) inactive permits from January 1, 2010 through the current date.
