



TYPE 3(E) Permits - Residential In-Ground Pool, Spa, and Above-Ground Pool
APPLICATION SUBMITTAL CHECKLIST*
(102 & 106 P.B.C. Amendments to the Florida Building Code 2004 and Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code)

Note: MUST check with other agencies for their specific requirements. Failure to do so, could result in significant delay to your permit.

- 1) Completed Application.
- 2) Owner/Builder Affidavit (Owner/Builder must appear personally to apply for a permit under this exception to the Florida State Licensing Laws), as applies.
- 3) For Owner/Builder applying for an In-Ground Pool or Spa.
- 4) Completed Private Swimming Pool Safety Requirements Affidavit of Understanding form.
- 5) Applicant acknowledges the requirement for separate sub-permits for electrical, gas (as applies), and each element of the pool barrier.

TWO IDENTICAL SETS OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 6) Surveys – final, tie-in or formboard acceptable, unless initial construction or otherwise noted. Include proposed improvements to create a site plan, drawn to scale and dimensioned, easements, rights of way, and existing structure locations. Provide distances or separations to the property lines and existing structures.
- 7) Engineered drawings for in-ground pools/spas.
- 8) Pool heater specification sheet (when applicable).
- 9) Electrical load calculation when electric pool heater is specified.
- 10) Manufacturer’s specifications for above ground pools.
- 11) Electric provisions shown on site plan for above ground pool installations.
- 12) Site work complies with 109.3.10 Palm Beach County Amendments (may require professional design), as applies.

OTHER AGENCIES, AS APPLY:

Environmental Resources Management – Refer to ERM for Requirements when on an unplatted parcel.

Florida Department of Environmental Protection Permit/Exemption for proposed construction seaward of coastal construction control line.

Army Corp of Engineers Approval must be provided at application when in the Intracoastal Right of Way Easement.
