

D.C.C. ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-71-193
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED JUNE 17, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 17th day of June, 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

Tracts 33 through 40, inclusive, Tracts 53 through 60, inclusive, Model Land Company's Subdivision of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 14, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 78, is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to R-2 Multiple Family Dwelling District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
