

AMENDING BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF PALM BEACH COUNTY

ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-98

ADOPTED April 20, 1972

WHEREAS, Kings Park Incorporated, petitioned the Palm Beach County Zoning Commission and Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County sitting as the final zoning authority on February 3, and 17, 1972, respectively, for the rezoning of a parcel of land located on the west side of proposed Jog Road and on the South side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806) from A-1 Agricultural District to C-1A Limited Commercial District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County Zoning Resolution No. R-72-98 adopted February 17, 1972, inadvertently contained a typographical error replacing the numeral "1/4" with the numeral "1/2" in line fourteen (14) of said resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this 20th day of April 1972, does hereby amend its former Zoning Resolution No. R-72-98, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970: replacing the numeral "1/2" in line fourteen (14) of aforesaid resolution with the corrected numeral "1/4"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Zoning Resolution No. R-72-98 is hereby ratified and adopted as amended.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Warren, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

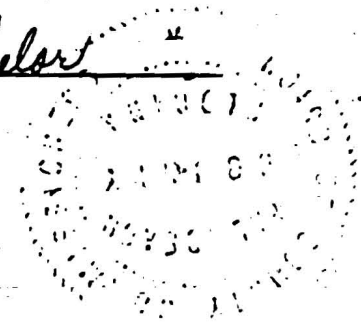
