AMENDED - Sec Meeting
held Sept. 21, 1972

MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED April 20, 1972

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 20th day of April 1972, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

The Easterly 370.21 feet, running parallel with the right-of-way of Military Trail, of the following described property: The Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 12, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, less the North 53.00 feet thereof, together with the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 12; less the East 250 feet thereof; is hereby rezoned from R-1 Single Family Dwelling District to C-1A Limited Commercial District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
