ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-229

MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED April 20, 1972

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 20th day of April 1972, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

Tracts 101, 102, 123 and 124, Block 77, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 18, Township 47 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 53, excepting therefrom the North 245 feet of Tract 102 and the North 245 feet of the West 105 feet of Tract 101; is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to R-1B Multiple Family Dwelling District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Warren, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
