

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 308

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-44 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 May 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of May, 1973, that petition No. 73-44, the petition of ~~JIMMY~~ K BOYD for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN ELECTRICAL AUTO REPAIR SHOP on Lots 13, 14, 15 and '16, less the East 17 feet of Lots 13, 14 and 15, Military Park, Diekhans Addition as recorded in Plat Book 12, page 56. Said property located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and Diekhans Road in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised.


