

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 381

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-84 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 June 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of June, 1973, that petition No. 73-84, the petition of EAST GEORGIA LAND COMPANY by Charles R. Pair, Vice President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL OF MUCK, SAND, ROCK, SHELL, SOIL OR OTHER EXTRACTIVE MATERIALS on the North 3/4 of the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 46 South, Range 42 East; less the East 620 feet thereof; together with the North 200 feet of the West 545 of the East 620 feet of the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 26. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809) approximately 1/4 mile south of Germantown Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner

Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


