

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163¹ and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-33 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 June 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of -June, 1974 , that petition No. 73-33, the petition of WEST PALM BEACH LODGE NO. 1352, BENEVOLENT AND PROTECTIVE ORDER OF ELKS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, by Edgar S. Armstrong, President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION on Tract 2, Block 5, Palm Beach. Farms Company Plat No. 3, recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45 to 54, inclusive; less the rights-of-way for Belvedere Road and L.W. D.D. Lateral Canal No. 3. Said property located on the south side of L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 3 on the east side of 62nd Drive North (First Street) in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


