

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-442

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-108 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of July, 1973, that petition No. 73-108, the petition of RAYMOND F. LEIGHTON, JR., for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of all that part of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 24, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, lying North of the railroad right-of-way; less the Southerly 210.00 feet of the Easterly 210.00 feet thereof and less the Southerly 210.75 feet of the remainder of the above parcel; and less right-of-way for Haverhill Road. Said property located on the east side of Haverhill Road approximately 1/2 mile north of Olceechobee Road (S.R. 704), was denied.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


The Chairman thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 7th day of August , 1973.
