

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 460

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-130 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of July, 1973, that petition No. 73-130, the petition of THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY by Lake Lytal, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT, of the North 339 feet of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 17, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, containing 10 acres more or less. Said property located on the east side of Congress Avenue approximately 1/4 mile south of Forest Hill Boulevard, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


