RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

MAYO, SR., for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A SECURITY KENNEL on the Easterly 84 feet of the Northerly 665 feet of the West 1/2 of Tract 62, and the Westerly 175 feet of the Northerly 665 feet of the East 1/2 of Tract 62, Block 5, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45 through 54 inclusive. Said property located on the south side of 2nd Place North (Wallis Street) approximately 200 feet north of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80) and approximately 250 feet east of 62nd Drive North (First Street), in an AG-Agrciultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

(1) The building shall be screened by foliage;

- (2) A six (6) foot high fence shall be constructed around the entire property;
