

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-615

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-107 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 September 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of September, 1973, that petition No. 73-107, the petition of KING'S POINT HOUSING CORPORATION by Henry G. Gray, Vice President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of the West 600 feet of the East 665 feet of the North 620 feet of the South 680 feet of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 23, Township 46 South, Range 42 East. Said property located at the northwest corner of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and German-town Road, was denied as advertised.
