

RESOLUTION NO. R-74-434

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-79 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 May 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day of May, 1974, that petition No. 74-79, the petition of THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT on the right-of-way for the North extension of Jog Road, being legally described as follows: the East 60 feet of Tracts 56,65 and 76 lying North of State Road 80, Block 5, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 46. Said property located on the north side of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80) approximately 1 1/2 miles west of Haverhill Road, was approved as advertised.
